# Liturgy of Pre-Sanctified Gifts

These Lenten Services are conducted for our spiritual Renewal here at St. Mary Magdalene each and every Wednesday and Friday at 7:00 p.m. during the Great Lent. Every effort should be made to attend these services so that we can better prepare ourselves to understand the meaning and significance of the Joy of Easter.

The Liturgy of the Pre-Sanctified Gifts is composed of Vesper prayers and hymns leading to the reception of Holy Communion. The Liturgy also includes scripture readings, solemn incensing ("Let my prayer rise like incense") and the solemn blessing with a candle in which the priest proclaims, "The light of Christ enlightens everyone."

It is a service in keeping with the themes of the Great Fast; an enlightening theme for the faithful to focus on the context of God's plan for salvation.
