### FINANCIAL UPDATE FOR OUR CHURCH CUPOLA AND ROOF REPAIR

**As of 12/22/2024 our generous parishioners have donated \$33,000 to repair our church roof.** For the last several months Father and members of the Pastor Advisory Council have met with roofing companies to receive estimates for repairing the cupola and replacing the church roof. Currently, estimates for these repairs are approximately \$100,000.

★ **Our church furnace and thermostat are being replaced after New Year's Day. The cost for this project is \$10,000.** Donations are welcomed for financing these repairs.
